We have the great pleasure of inviting you to the Launch conference of the eBio-hub project "eBio-hub: Chair of Research Center in Biomedical Engineering" held by the University Politehnica of Bucharest, within the action HORIZON WIDEERA -2022-TALENTS-01-01.

The main objective of eBio-hub is to establish a National Center of Excellence in Bioengineering within the Politehnica University of Bucharest. eBio-hub will become an interdisciplinary research center operating at the interface between chemistry, biology, IT, micro and nanotechnology and medicine, and is designed to develop micro, nano and bio-integrated solutions to address major global challenges in the biomedical field.
